Language Arts

- High Frequency Words: can, an, not
- Letter Recognition: Review – Aa, Bb, Cc, Dd, Ee, Ff, Gg, Hh, Ii, Jj, Kk, Ll, Mm, Nn, Oo, Pp, Qq, Rr, Ss, Tt
Introduce – Uu, Vv, Ww, Xx, Yy, Zz
- Listen and speaking: Following directions and reciting the alphabet
- Writing: Tracing, copying and writing the alphabet
- Text-Based Comprehension: Predict, retell, problem/solution & opinion in the book Chicka Chicka Boom Boom

Activities: This week, to build our reading readiness skills, we will be studying the letters in the entire alphabet. We will hear lots of classic children's literature that has the alphabet included in it. Students should be able to recognize ALL letters in their names and recite the alphabet, as well as recognize letters Aa to Zz.
