We heard great rhyming this week listening to all these books plus more. On Monday we had the following five guest readers come throughout the day to read to our class:

We finished Topic 9 and took an assessment on counting to 20 in math and started Topic II on numbers to 100. We need to brush up on counting to 100 because some of us haven't done that since our 100th day of school. I will be checking again to see who can do that and ALL of us should be able to. At the end of the week we worked on using patterns to help us see numbers up to 50. We will do more next week as we work our way to 100. Please practice counting and writing to 100 at home to help your kindergartener understand numbers 0-100! Thank you!
