Dear Kindergarten Parents,

This past week we have had a great time working with the shapes around us! We focused on the four basic shapes of circle, square, triangle and rectangle. First of all, we met Shape Man who was built out of all different shapes. Then each day we met a turtle who liked a certain shape. We met Jina Jurtle who likes circles, Jommy Jurtle who likes squares, Jimmy Jurtle who likes triangles and Jammy Jurtle who likes rectangles. We have been working on our fine motor skills of cutting and gluing. Slow but sure we are learning our shapes! We practiced shape recognition as we sang the songs "Triangle, Circle and Square" and "Shapes". We also reviewed the shapes by reading the shape books The Shape of Things, Circle Dogs, Bear In A Square, Snake Gets In Shape and Color Farm. We even made our own class shape book entitled Shapes Around Us. We had such shape food snacks as Honey Nut Cheerios in a circular cup, Graham Crackers on a rectangular napkin, triangle pita crackers on a triangular plate and Cheez-Its on a square napkin. Joday we made our own Shape Man to practice with at home but right now we are displaying them in the hallway. As you are out and about at different places have your child look for these four basic shapes: circle, square, triangle and rectangle.

Next week we will be focusing on numbers 1 through 5. Please practice over the weekend recognizing these numbers. Look at road signs, boxes, magazines, clocks and anywhere you may find numbers! Take a short time to practice writing and counting these numbers too!
